This policy is to replace ALL other swim squad subsidies (excludes Wednesday morning surf swims).

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to provide clear guidelines for all Active Members with respect to claiming a subsidy (rebate) to assist with the cost of squad swimming to support fitness for patrol duties and/or relevant surf sports activities.

#### **Application**

Applies to all patrolling Active & SRC award members who have met their patrol obligations as per the Patrol Handbook, and Nippers u11-u14 who have paid the annual Surf Sports Levy. Refer to the Patrol and/or Surf Sports Handbook for more information. Long Service & Life Members need only complete 20 patrol hours/season to qualify for this subsidy, with their patrol roster obligations pro-rata'd for these reduced hours.

#### **Policy**

SBSLSC will pay a rebate of 30% of the fee for squad swimming capped at \$500 per person per year. The year shall commence on 1<sup>st</sup> August all rebates shall be paid on a quarterly basis on 31 October, 31 January, 30 April & 31 July.

Subsidy must be claimed within the quarter the squad fees are incurred. Claims outside the quarter the fee is incurred will not be paid.

The subsidy applies to squad swimming fees charged by any coach at any pool. Such subsidy does not apply to swimming lessons.

All claims must be submitted on the prescribed form and must include a copy of the receipt for fees relevant to the subsidy claimed.

The Club reserves the right to refuse reimbursement where the applicant is found to be negligent or involved in any disciplinary matter.
