Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to provide clear guidelines with respect to the uniform (items of clothing) that Sunshine Beach competitors may wear when representing the club at an approved event

Application

Applies to U11 – Masters active Surf Sports, Pool Rescue and Surf Rescue Competitors

Policy

The Sunshine Beach SLSC Board of Management has approved and endorsed a preferred uniform to be worn by competitors involved in the Surf Sports Program. Each competitor must adhere to the endorsed Uniform Policy at all times when representing the club at an approved event. The purpose of the uniform is to create a professional team culture and image that both the competitor and club can be proud of. The Surf Sports Uniform to be worn by competitors consists of:

U11-13's

- Team Jacket
- Club approved Black Swimwear
- Club White Club Polo Shirt
- Club Red Sun Safe Shirt
- Club Black Board Shorts
- High Vis Pink Rashie

U14's- Opens

- Team Jacket
- Club White Club Polo Shirt
- Club Red Sun Safe Shirt
- Club Black Board Shorts
- High Vis Pink Rashie
- State and or Australian Titles attire.
- U14 – Open competitors are also allowed to wear red swimwear as long as it has been agreed upon and communicated prior to the Senior carnival and ALL competitors at that carnival have agreed to wear matching red swimwear. If it is not possible for everyone to wear red, then black must be worn.
- When u14 & u15 competitors are competing at the same carnival with junior club members (u11 – 13) they must wear black swimwear to match with the rest of the club.
